Did you know that tax payments are always due the 1st Monday of **March, May, and October** and the 2nd Monday in **August**?

Online payments and pre-authorized payment (PAP) plans help you coordinate your payments at no additional charge. Our monthly plan is 11 months, so there is no withdrawal in December.

Payments cannot be made by credit card.

Did You Know...

- If you **demolish a structure** you have to **file an application with the Finance Department** in order for your property's current value assessment to reflect the change.
- Any **improvement or addition** to your property will increase the current value assessment. Taxes can be levied on this new value for the **current year and 2 years prior**. Keep this in mind when budgeting after an improvement or an addition.
- The **Municipal Property Assessment Corporation (MPAC)** provides the Township with the assessed value of your property for tax billing purposes. Visit their website for more information: www.mpac.ca
- **Dog Licencing** - all dog owners are required to purchase and keep their dog tags current.
- **Move right for the green light.** Help our volunteer firefighters - please pull over when you see a flashing green light.
