Subject: Peterborough County Postpones Off Road Vehicle Decision

Today, County Council approved a recommendation to direct staff to prepare and issue a Request for Proposal (RFP) for the purpose of updating the 2014 Transportation Master Plan that includes a comprehensive review and public consultation process concerning the use of ORVs on County roadways.

At this time, there have been no changes to the list of County Roads with ORV Allowances.

County Roads with Off Road Vehicle Allowances:

County Road 46

- From Mclean Avenue to Baker Side Road
- From 8th Line to Church Road
- 6 short sections between north of Fire Road 71 and north of Fire Road 79
- From Vansickle Trail to Post Road
- From East Post Road to point north of south boundary lot 7
- From Fire Road 68 to Twin Lakes Motel

County Road 48

- From Preston Road to Concession 1, Belmont Township
- Mary Street, Hwy 7 north
- From trail at 6th Line to Weller Road
- From Fire road 8 to Bowen Road
- From Preston Road to Hastings County Boundary (Cordova)

Off Road Vehicles are only allowed on the currently approved County Roads as listed above.

All other County Roads do not allow Off Road Vehicles (ORVs). Anyone that encounters an ATV/ORV on unapproved County roads may contact the OPP where necessary.
