2020 Polar Paddle Competitor Information

Teams bringing their own canoe must have the canoe on site (Village parking lot beside Village Inn) by 12:30 pm on competition day for inspection.

All team members must sign the entry form waiver.

There is a mandatory competitors meeting at 12:15 p.m. sharp on Competition day (Feb. 1) in the lobby of the Village Inn. 2 members from each team must attend.

All teams are responsible for supplying helmets and life jackets for their 2 team members riding in the canoes.

Washrooms are available downstairs in the Village Inn.

Racing starts at 1 p.m.

While not mandatory, we would ask in the name of good sportsmanship, that all teams stay to the end of competition to cheer on the remaining teams and to be present at the awards ceremony.
