

RULES OF OPERATION FOR LIBRARY INTERNET COMPUTERS

1. Users shall not access, display, download, upload, print, forward or e-mail pornographic, obscene, or criminal material (as defined by the Criminal Code of Canada) or material inciting hatred or sedition.
2. Users may not interfere with the quiet enjoyment of the library by the general public, through disruptive behavior or the displaying of disturbing information and images.
3. Children 15 and under must have a signed permission form from their parent/guardian on file ; or a parent/guardian must be present in the library to supervise.
4. Users must limit their use of the workstation to 30 minutes if people are waiting. No more than two 30-minute periods are permitted in a day.
5. A maximum of two people may work at a workstation at one time.
6. Users must sign-in before using computer, indicating name and correct time.
7. Users must pay for all printing. Cost 15 cents per page.
8. Users may not access other areas of the computer; run personal software or compromise system security.
