


**Notice of Public Information Centre  
Township of Selwyn  
Ennis and Tara Road Community Improvements**



The Township of Selwyn is planning to construct pedestrian facilities (sidewalk) on the north side of Ennis Road, from Earl Avenue to east of the Robert E. Young Recreational Complex entrance. Barrier curbs will be placed at the crest of Ennis Road adjacent to St. Martin Catholic Elementary School, on both sides of the road to increase safety and visibility of pedestrians and bus turning movements. The design at the intersection of Ennis & Tara Road includes enhanced community features such as benches, lighting, planters, decorative fences, and wayfinding features. The study area has a requirement for curb-side parking and clear paths for commercial truck deliveries and snow clearing maintenance. The addition of catch-basins, curb, and gutters west of Tara Road will improve the existing drainage condition, by directing runoff away from buildings and walkways. The purpose of this project is to improve pedestrian safety and infrastructure, to reconstruct the boulevards to an urban standard with curb, gutters, and sidewalk, and to provide beautification and enhancement to the main intersection while maintaining existing parking and delivery access.



A Public Information Centre (PIC) will be held on Wednesday May 11, 2022 from 4:30 pm to 6:30 pm at the Ennismore Community Centre – upper level, in the Township of Selwyn. The purpose of this PIC is to provide information about the proposed scope of the project, present plans showing the proposed improvements and to receive input about any local issues within the study area. The PIC will be a drop-in format with displays showing proposed work. Staff from the Township and the Consultant team will be on hand to answer any questions. Subject to comments received and the receipt of necessary approvals, the Township intends to proceed with the construction of this project in the summer of 2023.
