

## How to Make a Complaint / Report an Issue?

Is It An Emergency? Call 9-1-1. Emergency = dangerous, safety issues, excessive noise	
<ul> <li>Impaired driving (boating and vehicles)</li> <li>Out of control burning, unattended fires, nuisance smoke, fires during a burn ban, etc.</li> <li>Dangerous misuse of fireworks</li> <li>Violence, threatening behaviour</li> <li>Excessive / disruptive noise – amplified music, yelling, shouting, etc.</li> <li>Vehicles blocking an entrance or the roadway preventing access for other vehicles or emergency vehicles</li> </ul>	9-1-1 Know your street address!
<ul> <li>Animals – stray animal (running at large), immediate welfare concern</li> </ul>	Peterborough Humane Society (705) 745-4722
