If you should notice iron coloured water, please let your cold water tap closest to the source run for 20-30 minutes or until the water clears.

Check Your 911 Signs!

Selwyn Township and Peterborough County are reviewing 911 address signage across the municipality to prepare for the transition to Next Generation 911, a federally mandated modernization of Canada's emergency communications network.



It is your responsibility to repair or replace your 911 emergency sign and to clear any obstructions!

Accurate and visible 911 address signs are essential for ensuring emergency services can quickly locate properties. All residents must comply with the **Township's Civic Addressing By-law.**

- Small campfires are permitted except in built-up areas (e.g. Lakefield, Bridgenorth, Woodland Acres, Hamlets of Ennismore and Young's Point and generally in subdivisions).
