### **Ice Storm Update**

### Free Brush Drop-Off

Please DO NOT place your storm-related brush on the roadside. You are responsible for disposing your brush. Brush can be disposed of at the locations

below.

#### Peterborough County Depots (free-of-charge until May 20th):

If you receive your Tax bill by email, your landfill pass will be waiting for you at the Smith Landfill. Replacement Landfill Passes can be purchased at the Landfill for \$10.00.

### **Township Roadside Storm Debris Clean-up and Street Sweeping**

Township Public Works crews have been clearing storm debris along Township roadsides. Again, we ask that residents manage the storm debris from their own properties and take brush to the Landfill or one of the County of Peterborough depots (where available). This roadside work is expected to take 3 to 4 weeks, depending on the amount of brush collected.

#### **Street Sweeping**

This brushing work will delay this year's street sweeping program by at least 3 to 4 weeks. Note: Peterborough County manages street sweeping on Bridge and Queen Streets in Lakefield and Ward Street in Bridgenorth



### **Keep Private Roads Clear!**

Please ensure that the road is in a good state of repair so that emergency and other service vehicles can access your property. Property owners on privately maintained roads are responsible for maintenance.

With the recent ice storm there may be brush/downed trees etc.. impacting access. In addition, many private roads have potholes/washouts etc... making roads rough to travel over.

Ensure that any obstacles on, and adjacent, to the road have been removed. Fill potholes and grade your roads as well. This work will ensure that important services can access your property.

### **Lakefield Water Main Flushing**

In order to sustain water quality in the water distribution system, the Township of Selwyn once again intends to perform routine flushing of water mains throughout Lakefield.

The flushing will be conducted generally between **April 14th to May 30th, 2025** during anytime of the day or night.



If you should notice iron coloured water, please let your cold water tap closest to the source run for 20-30 minutes or until the water clears.

### **Spring is Here!**



Curbside leaf and yard waste collection begins on Mondays at 7:00 AM - but may occur any day throughout the week. Accepted items include:

- Leaves
- Branches\*, hedge and tree trimmings
- House and garden plants

Materials may be placed in paper bags or reusable containers for collection. Materials in plastic bags of any kind will NOT be collected.

\*Branches may be bundled with string and bundles should be no larger than 1m by 30cm (3' by 1'). Bundles are **not** to be placed in the paper leaf bags. No limit on the amount being picked up and no tags required.
