**A By-law to adopt County of Peterborough Official
Plan Amendment No. 58 – File No. 15OP-19007,
Selwyn Cannabis Cultivation and Processing Official
Plan Amendment, Township of Selwyn**

Whereas Sections 17 and 21 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990 Chapter P. 13, as amended provides for the process and manner in which an amendment to an upper tier municipality's Official Plan shall be undertaken and adopted by the upper tier municipality;

And Whereas at the County Council Meeting of February 19, 2020, County Council accepted the recommendations in the Manager of Planning's report "PLG 2020-003 Selwyn Cannabis Cultivation and Processing Official Plan Amendment (OPA No. 58)";

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the County of Peterborough in session duly assembled enacts as follows:

1. Amendment No. 58 to the County of Peterborough Official Plan consisting of the attached explanatory text identified as Schedule "A" to this By-law is hereby adopted and the Schedule forms an integral part of this By-law.
2. That the Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to proceed with the giving of notice under Section 17(23) of the Planning Act.
3. This By-law shall come into force and effect on the day of the final passing hereof.


