Rate increases will be phased-in and will support operational improvements, enhanced diversion of recyclable/reusable materials, adherence to Environmental Compliance Approval requirements and compliance with the mandatory Clear Bag Program (mandatory September 1, 2021). These efforts will assist to preserve the life of the landfill site and mitigate future tax increases required to support operations and the eventual closure and ongoing monitoring requirements for the site.

There are four options when it comes to your dog's license - make sure you have provided the applicable supporting documentation if your dog qualifies for one of these rates. 2022 invoices will be sent in January - fees cannot be modified after December 31st.

As of September 1, 2021, clear garbage bags will be mandatory for curbside collection and at the landfill site.



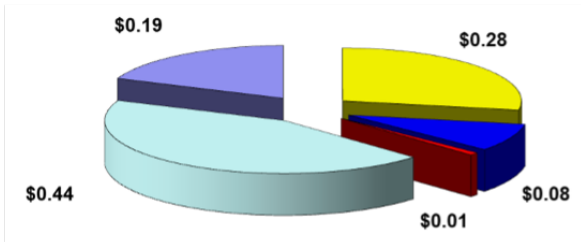
- One (1) opaque privacy bag (grocery bag sized) permitted per clear bag or container

2021 Distribution of Residential Tax Dollar

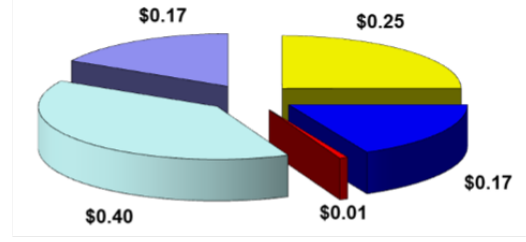
Rural Ratepayer:

Open Air Burning in Selwyn

- Campfires (fire pits or containers) are not permitted in built-up areas;
- Campfires in all other areas are permitted and do not require a permit;
- A 1:10 "ratio for fire-safe distance" must be established (ex: a fire measuring 2 feet in diameter requires 20 feet of clearance in all directions);
- Certified gas-fueled outdoor appliances are permitted throughout the Township;
- Burning of noxious materials, leaves, grass clippings or compost is not permitted; and
- Permits are required for brush fires and there are new requirements.
