

## Department 23 – Streetlights

---

### Overview

Streetlights in various parts of the municipality are the responsibility of the Township. Certain streetlights at controlled intersections are covered by the authority responsible for traffic signalization. (i.e., the County or Province)

Street lighting throughout the Township is traditionally present in settlement and built-up areas only.

Staff completed an inventory of streetlights in September 2025 at the request of Hydro One. The township currently maintains 719 streetlights including decorative lights.

### Revenues

Street lighting throughout the Township is funded through the general tax levy.

### Expenditures

With the causeway and bridge work now completed an additional 33 lights have been added to the Township inventory in 2025.

An additional 7 lights will be added to the Township account in 2026 for the new light standards on Tara and Ennis Roads for the Ennismore Community Improvement program completed in 2025.



### Activity Update – Beyond Budget and Dollars and Cents

Design for County improvements to Ward Street will take place in 2026. This will include public realm elements of the Bridgenorth CIP, incorporating updated street and pedestrian lighting components.
