

Important ReminderCurbside Recycling to end January 1st, 2026 (NES Properties)

Effective **January 1, 2026**, curbside recycling collection will no longer be provided for non-eligible source (NES) properties.

What is a non-eligible source/ is my property a non-eligible source?

Non-eligible sources include:

- Businesses (retail, grocery, offices, food service, restaurants, gas bars, marinas)
- Places of Worship (church, synagogue, mosque, temple, community centre within a church)
- Municipal Buildings (library, community centres, arenas, municipal offices, shelters)
- Daycares (within a church, within a school, in home, stand alone)
- Charities (not-for-profit, charity events)
- Commercial farms (farm operation, barn, office)
- Campground/trailer park without seasonal residents

What options do non-eligible sources have for disposing of recyclables as of January 1st, 2026?

In addition to the information previously provided by the County of Peterborough (also listed below), we would like to share further options for independent recycling.

Option 1 - Drop-Off Locations:

Non-eligible sources may arrange to drop-off recyclables at the following locations:

Option 2 - Collection Services - Pick-up:

Non-eligible sources may arrange bin rentals and pick-up services individually or in partnership with others.

Important Notes

- NES is mandated by the Province of Ontario.
- The Township of Selwyn recommends securing a service provider or drop-off options before December 31, 2025 to avoid disruption.
- Non-eligible source recycling CANNOT be taken to the Smith Landfill Recycling Depot (1480 County Rd 18). To maintain compliance, the Township must keep residential recycling separate from non-eligible sources.
- The Township of Selwyn does not endorse or guarantee any of the listed service providers.
- This does NOT impact your garbage collection. Your curbside garbage collection, if applicable, will continue as usual.
- This does NOT impact curbside collection of recyclables at your **residential property** (includes apartments co-located with a business).
- Holiday Reminder: If your garbage collection takes place on Thursday or Friday collection will shift by one day (see enclosed flyer)
