

Lot Grading Plans, Surveys and Foundation Certificates

1) Lot Grading Plans

- 1. A permit application **must** include an **Engineered Lot Grading Plan** or a building permit will NOT be processed.
- 2. For parcels 0.5 ha (1.25 acres) and smaller, the entire lot shall be shown and shall include existing grades, proposed grades and proposed swales designed to good engineering standards.
- 3. For parcels larger than 0.5 ha (1.25 acres); a minimum distance of 15 m from the proposed dwelling shall be included in the engineered lot grading plan and shall include existing grades, proposed grades and proposed swales designed to good engineering standards.
- 4. For construction within a plan of subdivision/condominium the Engineered Lot Grading Plan shall be developed in conformance of the General Lot Grading Plan and agreement for the plan of subdivision/condominium.

2) Plans of Survey

- 1. A final location survey showing the dwelling under construction and the distance to property lines shall be submitted before the permit file will be closed for parcels up to 1 ha.
- 2. A final location survey showing the dwelling under construction and the distance to property lines will be required for any property subject to a minor variance for setback relief or any new residential building within a plan of subdivision/condominium.

3) Foundation Certificates

 A foundation certificate indicating the geodetic elevation of the top of foundation wall shall be submitted for any new residential building before framing commences.
